ARC-PA Standard:

Section A: Administration

Sponsorship: A1.01

When more than one institution is involved in the provision of academic and/or clinical education, responsibilities of the respective institutions for instruction and supervision of students must be clearly described and documented ... Read More >

Program Personnel: A2.05

Principal faculty and the program director must be responsible for, and actively participate in the processes of: a) developing, reviewing and revising as necessary the mission statement, goals and competencies of the program... Read More >

Program Personnel: A2.16

The program must a) verify and document that all instructional faculty actively serving as supervised clinical practice experience preceptors hold a valid license that allows them to practice at the clinical site, ... Read More >

Operations: A3.17

Student academic records kept by the sponsoring institution or program, in a paper or electronic format, must be readily accessible to authorized program personnel and must include documentation... Read More >







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Section B: Curriculum and Instruction

Curriculum: B1.03

For each didactic and clinical course (including required and elective rotations), the program must define and publish learning outcomes and instructional objectives, in measurable terms that can be assessed, and that guide student acquisition of required competencies... Read More >

Didactic Instruction: B2.04

The curriculum must include instruction in interpersonal and communication skills that result in the effective exchange of information and collaboration with patients, their families and other health professionals.... Read More >

Didactic Instruction: B2.07

The curriculum must include instruction in patient evaluation, diagnosis and management across all age groups and from initial presentation through ongoing follow-up, including: a) interviewing and eliciting a medical history, ... <u>Read More ></u>

Didactic Instruction: B2.08

The curriculum must include instruction in: a) the provision of medical care across the life span including prenatal, infant, children, adolescents, adults and elderly, ... Read More >

Didactic Instruction: B2.12

The curriculum must include instruction about basic counseling and patient education skills that is patient centered, culturally sensitive and focused on helping patients: a) adhere to treatment plans, ... Read More >

Clinical Practice Experience: B3.01

The program must secure clinical sites and preceptors in sufficient numbers to allow all students to meet the program's learning outcomes for supervised clinical practice experiences... Read More >

Supervised clinical practice experiences should occur with: a) physicians who are specialty board certified in their area of instruction. b) NCCPA certified PAs ,... Read More >

Supervised clinical practice experiences must occur with preceptors who enable students to meet program defined learning outcomes for ... Read More >

Assessment of Student Learning: B4.01

The program must conduct frequent, objective and documented evaluations of student performance in meeting the program's learning outcomes and instructional objectives for both... Read More >


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Assessment of Student Learning: B4.03

Evaluation: C1.02

The program must implement its ongoing self-assessment process by a) conducting data collection, b) performing critical analysis of data, and <u>Read More ></u>

Clinical Site Evaluation: C2.01

The program must define and maintain effective processes and document the initial and ongoing evaluation of all sites and preceptors used for supervised clinical practice experiences, to ensure students are able to fulfill program learning outcomes with access to :.... <u>Read More ></u>

Section D: Provisional Accreditation

Provisional Accreditation: D1.05

The program must have signed agreements from prospective clinical sites participating in the supervised clinical practice experiences sufficient in number to meet the needs of the maximum class size ... Read More >







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
