1. Open the Google Authenticator App, press the **Plus** button in the bottom right corner to add your ELMS account.





2. Scan the **QR Code** with your phone's camera found on your ELMS login page, or enter the **"Secret Key"** provided on the ELMS login page.





- A new account for ELMS will populate containing a 6-digit code which refreshes every 30 seconds.
- Enter the code provided from the **Google Authenticator App** into ELMS to active the Two-Factor Authentication.
- Make sure you enter your code before it expires!





Going forward:

- Log into ELMS as you normally would
- The screen below will appear after logging in with your username and password.
- Use the **Google Authenticator App** to generate your code to enter into ELMS.

To use on computer/laptop:

 Download "Authenticator" Google Chrome Extension from the Google Chrome Web Store by clicking Add to Chrome





To use on computer/laptop:

- Once it is added as an extension, you will find the logo in the top right corner of your Google Chrome page
- Click the extension and then the square box in the top right corner to add your ELMS Account



• You will be prompted to capture your **QR code** from ELMS.
